RESOLUTION NO.3/ 1991./ II. 7./ OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY ON ACCEPTING THE STATUS OF ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP OFFERED BY THE NORTH ATLANTIC ASSEMBLY TO THE HUNGARIAN NATIONAL ASSEMBLY

The Hungarian National Assembly,

welcoming that the "Paris Charter for a new Europe" signed at the summit meeting on 16 November 1990 declares the closure of the age of confrontation and division and the beginning of an age of co-operation in Europe based on democracy, mutual security and common interests.

highly appreciating the contribution of the North Atlantic Assembly to the development of co-operation between the North Atlantic Alliance and the new democracies of Central and Eastern Europe and to the encouragement to provide assistance to the establishment of democratic institutions and market economy,

emphasizing that the development of close and institutionalized relations with the parliamentary bodies of the organizations of European integration: the Council of Europe, the European Communities, the Western European Union and the North Atlantic Alliance is an indispensable element of the international relations of the Republic of Hungary and its integration into Europe,

adopts the following resolution:

- 1. It accepts the invitation contained in Resolution No.224 of the North Atlantic Assembly which offers participation as an associated member in the activities of the North Atlantic Assembly to the delegation of the Hungarian National Assembly.
- 2. It requests the Speaker of the National Assembly to issue a letter of assignment to the heads and elected members of the delegations participating in the plenary meetings, the committees and sub-committees of the North Atlantic Assembly, following concertation with the House Committee and the Foreign Affairs Committee.
- 3. It calls on the elected members of the delegation of the Hungarian National Assembly to effectively assist the North Atlantic Assembly to fulfill its task of promoting the economic transformation, a functioning democracy as well as peace and stability in Central and Eastern Europe in accordance with Resolution No.224 of the North Atlantic Assembly.
- 4. It invites the North Atlantic Assembly to hold one of its annual meetings in Budapest at an appropriate time.
